Thank you for considering an investment of your time in the 2019 Mission to Mission Charity Bike Tour. For twenty years the M2M Tour has successfully spread the word about the Southside and its historic missions while reinvesting proceeds in local charities. This year the tour celebrates the Missions National Historical Park as a world Heritage site.

Last year with community and business support, MTR Charities was able to grant more than \$15,000 to 12 local charities. These grants helped complete small but essential projects in the San Antonio community that remained unfunded.

Mission to Mission has no paid staff, no office, and depends entirely on volunteers to plan and conduct the bike tour. MTR Charities, Inc. is a 501c3 entity with Mission Trail Rotary, Inc. providing the volunteer staff and Cool Cats Cycling Club the route support. After paying the business expenses, all the remaining rider and sponsor donations are contributed to selected neighborhood charities.

EZ Volunteer

Step 1: Invite family, friends, or colleagues to join you-multiply the fun!

Step 2: Print the last page of this document “**Volunteer Waiver**” for each volunteer.

Children/youth 17 or younger must also have a parent/guardian sign their waiver.

Step 3: Email your name(s), time available, email/phone contact.

Step 4: Mark your calendar and arrive at Mission Park Pavilions a before the start time for your shift(s). You will receive your assignment as you check in.

Step 5: Walk or drive to your station. Riders will begin to pass locations by 9:30 AM and continue to pass some locations until 1 or 2 PM.

Step 6: Return to registration to check out, return equipment, and receive “volunteer hours” certificate.

7:30-8:00 AM Morning

General Location: ¼ Mile from Mission San Jose

Major city north/south street access: South Presa or Roosevelt Ave

South Bound on 281: take the first exit south of I-10/281 intersection (Fair Ave Exit). Drive west on Fair Avenue. Continue through traffic lights until Fair Ave dead ends at South Presa. Turn left (south) on South Presa for just shy of 1 mile. Turn right (west) at VFW Blvd (formerly E. White) for 1/5 mile (over RR tracks and SA River). Turn left on Padre Dr. And immediate left into Mission Park Pavilions.

Dress for variable weather conditions. Should the weather turn questionable, a decision will be made on safety grounds NLT 8:30 AM (earlier if dangerous conditions are forecast for the entire day and are present at the time of on-site registration).

- 1) Park in the Mission Park Pavilions lot or as directed. (7:30 AM)
- 2) Check in at Volunteer Desk with completed volunteer form.
- 3) Drive/ Walk to assignment immediately or NLT 9:00 AM for Family Tour break point.
- 4) When relieved return to Volunteer Desk for Check Out and Volunteer Hours.

Water and coffee will be available when you check in. Please bring a water bottle.

Volunteer: Waiver Terms and Conditions

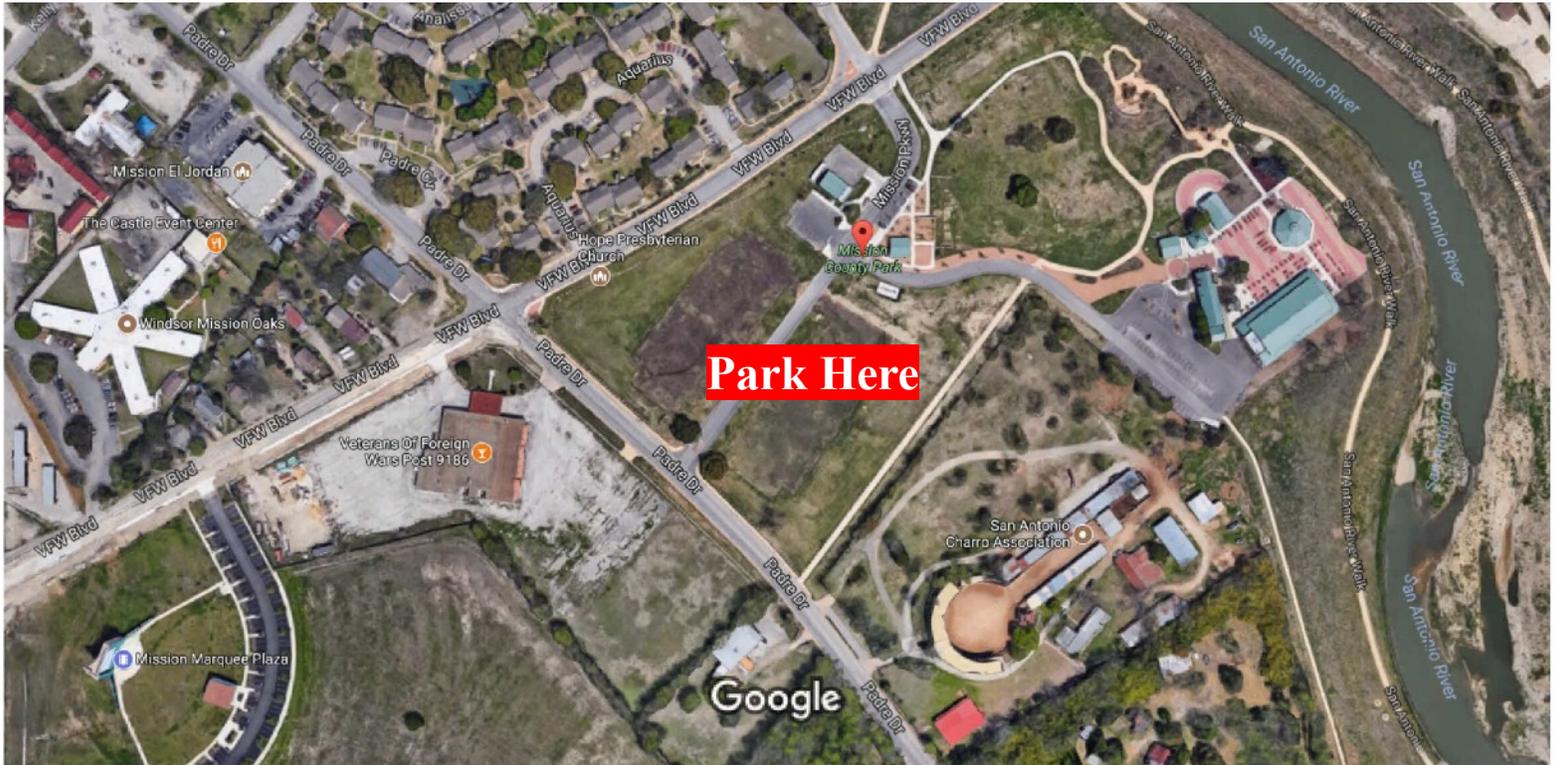
I fully realize the dangers of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, riders, and fixed or moving objects; the dangers arising from surface hazards, and weather conditions; and the possibility of serious physical and/or mental trauma, injury or even death associated with cycling events.

I hereby waive, release, and discharge for myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators, legal representatives, assigns and successors in interest (herein after collectively "successors") any and all events, the promoter, the San Antonio Mission Trail Rotary Club, MTR Charities, Inc, and any promoting organization's property owners, law enforcement agencies and all public entities through or by which the events will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or rising out of, my participation in or association with the event or travel to or return from the event I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the course, the rules and special regulations for the event. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the ride which may be beyond the immediate control of the ride officials or organizers, and I must continually ride or walk so as to neither endanger myself or others. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment. I have no physical or medical condition which to my knowledge would endanger me or other as I participate in this event. I agree, for myself and successors, that the above representations are contractually binding and are not mere recitals and that I should, or my successors shall, be liable for all expenses (including legal fees) incurred by other party or parties in defending, unless the party or parties are finally adjudged liable on such claim for willful and wanton negligence.

This agreement shall not be modified orally, and a waiver of any provision shall not be construed as a modification of any other provisions herein. The Mission Trail Rotary Club event, sponsors, and/or their agents shall be permitted to use photography and records of this event for any purpose. All participating volunteers, if required to ride must wear safety approved bicycle helmets and follow State and local traffic laws. All volunteers should wear appropriate, visible attire.
